DRIVING RULES IN ARGENTINA

- International Driving License is recognized.
- Both International Driving License and Inter-American Driving Permit are recognized.
- International Driving License recommended.

Driving tips for Argentina:

- Driving in Argentina is on the right side of the road.
- Seat belt is a must for everyone.
- The maximum permitted speed limit is 40-60 km/h on urban roads, 110 km/h on rural roads and 120-130 km/h on highways.
- The maximum allowed alcohol limit is 50 mg per 100 ml of blood.
- The minimum driving age is 18, the minimum rental age is 21.
- Avoid driving at night.
- Don't leave your car in a poorly lit place. Otherwise, it may be hijacked.
- For children under 12, use an appropriate restraint system.
- Make sure you have two emergency road triangles, a tow rope, a first-aid kit, a fire extinguisher as well as a red reflective tape to be attached to the rear side of the car.
- Hands-free is a must.
